Thank you for contacting the National Personnel Records Center. The Official Military Personnel File (OMPF) needed to answer your inquiry is not in our files. If the OMPF were here on July 12, 1973, it would have been in the area that suffered the most damage in the fire on that date and may have been destroyed. The fire destroyed the major portion of records of Army military personnel for the period 1912 through 1959, and records of Air Force personnel with surnames Hubbard through Z for the period 1947 through 1963.


An alternate record that is available for the veteran named in your request is a *Final Pay Voucher*. This particular document is an archival document belonging to the National Archives and is available to you for a fee. To help you decide if you would like to purchase the final pay voucher pertaining to the veteran named in your request, we are enclosing information about the document and a sample copy of an actual final pay voucher.

If you are interested in purchasing the final pay voucher, please complete the attached '*Order for Archival Record Reproduction Services*' form. Please return this form with your payment within 30 days. Once payment is received, a photocopy of the final pay voucher will be mailed to you. If payment is not received within this period, we will assume that you do not wish to purchase the document and your request will be closed automatically without further action.

### World War II Single Name Final Pay Vouchers

The National Archives and Records Administration (NARA) has identified several series of records which may be used by researchers to “reconstruct” portions of an individual’s Military Personnel File, in the event that this file was destroyed in the National Personnel Records Center fire of 1973. A primary source of alternate data is a collection of final pay vouchers. This Fact Sheet will help you interpret the information found in these records.

Information located within easily identifiable fields in these records includes:

- Name;
- Serial number;
- Grade or rank;
- Home address (generally valid for three months following discharge);
- Unit assignment at discharge;
- Place and date of entry;
- Place and date of discharge;
- Previous organization;
- Character of service;
- Discharge authority;
- Years of service;
- Signature of veteran.

The following information may also be available. The numbers below correspond with the numbers on the attached sample.

1. The remarks may include any number of pieces of information, including payment allotments, and previous transfers.
2. Army component.
3. Indication of overseas service (date arrived U.S.).
4. Mustering-out pay (\$300 indicates at least 60 days of active service, part of which was served outside the continental US, including Alaska and Hawaii; \$200 indicates at least 60 days of active service within the continental US; \$100 indicates less than 60 days of active service) Receipt of MOP is an indication of an honorable discharge.
